## **Health prioritisation in national and international institutions**

The papers in the panel discuss different cases of how health has been prioritised or otherwise in national, regional and international contexts. The first paper examines Brazil's foreign policy on global health, comparing the institutional cultures of the health and foreign ministries. The second paper critically analyses the European Commission's Health in All Policies concept. The third paper considers why needed health regulations sometimes fail to emerge in international organisations.
